

the amount of noise generated. Our teams will be briefed on working responsibly in the local community.

On a small number of occasions, we'll have to set up temporary traffic management on local roads to enable us to work safely. Where this is necessary, it will only be for short durations.

Thursday 24 December 2020 – Tuesday 5 January 2021

No work will take place during this period. There will be no traffic management and access will remain open over the crossings.

Wednesday 6 January – Friday 5 March 2021

In the New Year we'll resume the construction works that began on 6 October as detailed above.

Saturday 6 March – Monday 5 April 2021

From early March we'll be replacing the existing level crossing equipment with the new, more modern system. There may be occasions where removing and installing crossing equipment generates noise, but this we've planned our work to minimise this. Some of this work will be undertaken during the night and, as mentioned above, we'll brief our staff so that we minimise the impact this has on residents.

We plan to maintain access over the crossings during this work, but they'll be manned by our staff who will indicate whether it is safe to cross. This will mean users may experience slightly longer waiting times.

Tuesday 6 – Sunday 11 April 2021

The installation of the new crossing equipment will mark the end of the project's construction work, and we aim to complete this by 5 April. Once this is done, we'll start to remove our equipment and temporary compound. As part of this work, we'll tidy the area up to make sure no mess is left behind.
